Teacher Found Dead in Lake House

Miss Kellner waited for her son to the very end

Altenau. Miss Martha Kellner, formerly the schoolteacher of the parish of Unterau, was found dead by a postman on Monday in her house on the shore of the new reservoir. According to the doctor, she had already died around the 21st of December. She was sitting in an armchair at the living-room window, looking out over the water.

Miss Kellner, 58, was the only resident who refused last year to leave her house before the valley was flooded. As the so-called Lake House stood above the future waterline, she was allowed to stay. Neighbours from the new village report that in

recent months she hardly left the house and was “waiting for someone”.

After the war Miss Kellner searched for years for her son Paul, who has been missing since the spring of 1945. He was twelve years old at the time. The funeral will take place on Saturday at the new cemetery. The vicar asks Miss Kellner’s former pupils to attend in large numbers.

According to the postman, the table in the house was laid for two, and a fire was still burning in the stove.

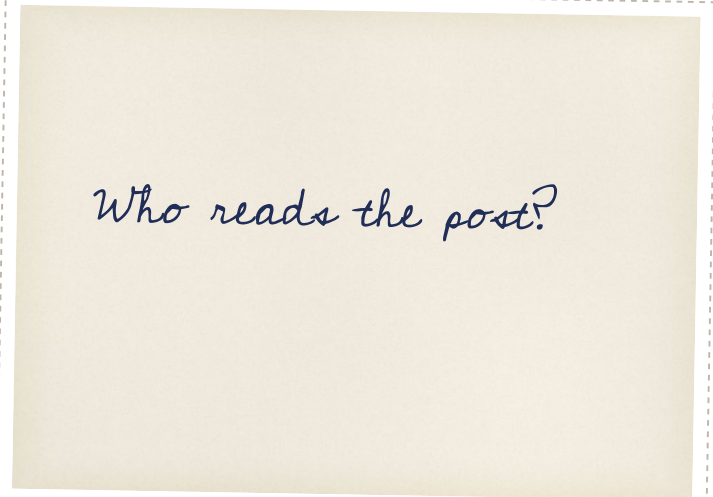
